



Furniture Painting Checklist



Clean

Clean the piece you wish to upcycle of any dust or dirt.



Sand

Sand the furniture removing any glossy finish. If the piece is already dull, skip this step.



Prime

Once the piece is dry and dust-free, paint the piece with a primer.



Sand

Sand the piece again, lightly to attain a more professional finish.



Paint

Paint the piece! Typically 2-3 coats will help you achieve your look.



Protect

Protect your painted piece by sealing it after at least 24 hours.
